A world first, ALGODeQ is a major new competition intended to recognize outstanding achievements in the increasingly influential field of algorithmic design, at the intersection between creativity and computing.

ALGODeQ is unlike conventional architecture competitions.

Rather than designs, ALGODeQ calls for mechanisms to produce designs = programs and their algorithms.

Algorithmic design is not simply the use of computers to design architecture. Algorithmic design is the use of algorithms to generate designs that are good and

beyond the capabilities of humans acting alone, and the use of computers to execute such algorithms.
